Daily Maintenance

One advantage of a Craft Art wood countertop is the very easy maintenance. Here's how it's done.

What you need:

- White Vinegar
- Water
- Squirt Bottle

How to clean:

1. Fill your squirt bottle 20% full of white vinegar.
2. Fill the remainder with water.
3. Shake, spray, and wipe!

The top can also be wiped down with a mild detergent that does not contain ammonia or bleach. Rinse the top with clean water and use a dry towel to remove excess water; let dry. After it is dry, mist the top with the vinegar solution and let dry. Vinegar is a natural - and inexpensive - disinfectant.

DO NOT USE:

Ammonia - Do NOT use ammonia-based cleaners; over time they will soften and cloud the finish. If damage occurs, visit www.craft-art.com for help.

Bleach - Do NOT use cleaners containing bleach; they can cause the finish to dry out and sustain damage that will require a refinish.
